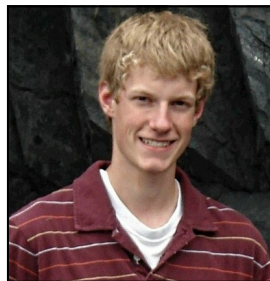

BOARD ACTION HIGHLIGHTS**

**Regular Meeting — March 25, 2010
ACTION TO:**

- Approve the 2009 Audit as presented by John Bost of Mikunda, Cottrell & Co., Inc.
- Approve a three-year agreement between KEA and IBEW Local Union #1547 for the Outside/Generation and Engineering contract, to be in effect for the period of May 1, 2010 through April 30, 2013.
- Approve the 2010 Scholarship allocations and awards recommended by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Approve the deletion of Policy 302 *Tree Attachment* and Policy 512 *Electric Magnetic Fields* and the proposed revisions to Policy 603 *Chain of Command* in the second reading.

**Special Meeting — April 13, 2010
ACTION TO:**

- Ratify the results of the 2010 balloting for Board Candidates as announced by Tally Committee Chairman Joan Altenhof at the Annual Membership Meeting on April 12, 2010.
- Elect 2010/2011 Board officers as follows: Chairman—Cliff Davidson, Vice Chairman—Ron Acarregui, and Secretary/Treasurer—Stosh Anderson.
- Establish the 2010/2011 monthly Regular Meetings of the KEA Board of Directors on the fourth Thursday of each month beginning at noon, with exceptions in the months of November and December.
